Brightmoor Community Center is dedicated to strengthening communities and empowering individuals by providing services and programs to today's youths, adults, and elderly citizens. We build on the strengths of our program participants rather than on their deficits, and in the belief that change is possible.

**CHILDREN & YOUTH**

**After-School Programs** (Youths 6-17 years): A variety of programs including arts and crafts, karate, tutoring and African Dance. Programs on-site and off-site with other community partners.

**B.A.B.E.S.** (Beginning Alcohol Addiction Basic Education Services): A prevention program presented to second grades using puppets and stories that address the concepts of self-esteem, sexual abuse, alcohol and drugs.

**Brightmoor Youth Adventure Leadership Training Program:** Hands-on leadership training for high school youth held during the summer

**Cub Scouts** (Boys grades 1-5): Fun, learning, character building, and family involvement. Weekly meetings.

**Detroit Young Citizens:** Teens (ages 14-17): Leadership development, social/recreational activities, community service; weekly meetings
